We are expanding your treatment options by adding more medications to our Prescription Drug List (PDL).

When making changes, we consider a medication's overall value, which is based on factors such as a medication's effectiveness, safety, cost, and the availability of alternative medications to treat the same or similar medical condition.

Prescription Drug List (PDL) update: effective as of 7/1/2026

- Prior authorization: Requires your health care provider to provide information about why you are taking a medication before your plan can decide how it may be covered.
- Quantity limit: The largest quantity of medication covered per copayment or in a defined period of time.
